The Department of Germanic and Slavic Studies at the University of Victoria invites applications for participation in the DAAD Fortbildungsseminar, to be held on November 3-5. This seminar presents a unique professional development opportunity for junior faculty, graduate teaching assistants and university teachers of German in the Western Prairie Provinces and the Pacific Northwest. This seminar is open to teachers of German at the post-secondary level only.

Through a series of dynamic and interactive workshops, participants will gain theoretical grounding in some of the most innovative developments in the field of *Deutsch als Fremdsprache* and practice new teaching approaches.

We begin with a welcome reception on the evening of Friday, November 3. The seminar takes place on Saturday, November 4, and will feature the following five workshops:

- Teaching and Learning Collocation to Achieve Advanced Language Competencies
- The Application of Film at All Levels of Language Instruction
- Drama Pedagogy Approaches to Teaching Tricky Transcultural Topics
- Developing Sample Lesson Plans

The seminar concludes on Sunday morning with a plenary discussion at breakfast.
